In case an entry is not accepted the Organiser will refund the entry fee reduced by any bank charges incurred during the banking process.

Competitors wishing to take part in 2023 Rally Italia Sardegna must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at http://registrations.fia.com/wrcita duly completed before the closing date for entries. The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry Fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of the entry fee payment by e-mail to m.furlanetto@rallyitaliasardegna.com by the entries closing date. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN in the same e-mail. Entrants who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championships available in the FIA application at https://registrations.fia.com/rally. Any entry form sent without the corresponding fee will not be taken into consideration and the Organiser has no obligation to inform the concerned party.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

5.1.1 LOCATION AND SPACES AVAILABLE

Location: Service Park 1 - Molo Brin; Service Park 2 - Isola Bianca

Inside the Service Park all entrants will have available the following spaces:

WRC Manufacturers, WRC Teams, WRC2 Teams, WRC2, P1/P2 or not priority drivers with RC1 cars and WRC3 will have the space recommended by the FIA. All other competitors will have an area of 8x10 meters.

Should an entrant require more space, he/she must contact the organisers (n.russo@rallyitaliasardegna.com) no later than Monday 15 May 2023. The organisers will try to satisfy the requests as much as possible according to the availability. After this date no request will be accepted.

5.1.2 ACCESS TO THE SERVICE PARK

SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates necessary to enter the Service Park, can be collected at the Accreditation Centre from Thursday 25 May from 09:00.

During the entire duration of the Rally, only cars provided with SERVICE or AUXILIARY plates distributed by the organiser will be allowed to enter the Service Park.

We remind you that the SERVICE plate is for vehicles (trucks, articulated lorry) that doesn't need to be moved once inside the Service Park, while AUXILIARY plate is for cars dedicated to move people. We remind as well that tractors and car carriers CANNOT remain in the Service Park. The dedicated parking for these vehicles is located in a place close to SP 2 – Isola Bianca.

Plates must be fixed inside the car, on the right side of the windscreen (co-driver side).

5.1.3 ALLOCATED SERVICE AREAS IN THE SERVICE PARK

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. P1(except the ones entered by a Manufacturer), P2, P3 and non Priority drivers wishing to use a joint area with other competitors must send a request to the organiser (n.russo@rallyitaliasardegna.com) by Monday 15 May 2023.

5.1.4 FACILITIES IN THE SERVICE PARK

The organiser will provide the following services to ALL competitors:

- waste collection for mixed waste, oil, paper, etc.;
- public toilets;
- general security in the Service Park area;
- electricity up to 3 Kw;
- water;
- car wash before entering the Service Park.

The organiser can provide at charge the following additional services:

- private security service:
- additional portable toilets inside the Teams' area;
- motorhome waste water emptying;
- electricity over 3 Kw;
- forklift service and sea container handling.

6. TWO WAY RADIO

6.1 LICENSE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to get the license it is compulsory to fill in and send the radio license application form to the organiser no later than Wednesday 10 May 2023 (Application form will be available upon request from the Permanent Secretariat and on the event website). The organiser will forward all requests to the Ministry of Communications with relevant details about frequency range. The Ministry of Communications will decide if the requested frequencies can be assigned and will issue a license. The Ministry Officials will monitor the use of radio transmitters during the Rally. Unlicensed use of a radio transmitter is forbidden and may lead to prohibition of the use of the transmitter, as well as a fine and/or the confiscation of the equipment.

8. HELICOPTERS

8.1 REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopters zones or other sites provided during the competition.

8.3 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

All pilots will get three stickers with an identification number that must be placed on the bottom and on both sides of the helicopter for the entire duration of the event.
